**Onondaga Lake Partnership announces release of the  
Progress Assessment and Action Strategies Report**

**Syracuse, N.Y.** – The Onondaga Lake Partnership (OLP) has released the ‘Onondaga Lake Watershed Progress Assessment and Action Strategies (PAAS) report’. The PAAS was developed by the OLP and prepared by Central New York Regional Planning and Development Board. The purpose of the PAAS is to provide a brief history of Onondaga Lake, the progress achieved to date in meeting the recommendations of the Onondaga Lake Management Plan, ‘A Plan for Action, December 1993’, and the OLP’s strategic plan for meeting lake management objectives. The report includes preliminary budget and funding needs for recommended projects to assist managers, developers, and elected government officials in the planning process for future development and construction of lake and watershed improvement projects.

In addition to the PAAS, the OLP created a PAAS Supplement which provides a brief overview of the PAAS report. The PAAS Supplement was also prepared by Central New York Regional Planning and Development Board and is only available in electronic format on the Partnership’s website at [www.onlakepartners.org](http://www.onlakepartners.org). Funding for the PAAS Supplement was provided by the U.S. Army Corps of Engineers, Buffalo District in cooperation with the OLP using American Recovery and Reinvestment Act funds.
